WHAT WE'LL SEE WHEN WE GET TO HEAVEN

WE'LL SEE MANY WONDERS WHEN WE GET TO HEAVEN...BUT THE LORD WILL OPEN OUR EYES TO SOME THINGS WE CAN'T SEE IN THIS WORLD.

WE'LL "SEE" THINGS THERE LIKE WE CAN'T HERE.

SOME OF THE THINGS WE'LL SEE ARE IN THESE VERSES

Revelation 22:1–2 And he shewed me a <u>pure river of water of life</u>, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, *was there* the <u>tree of life</u>, which bare <u>twelve manner of fruits</u>, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree *were* for the healing of the nations.

Revelation 22:5 And there shall be <u>no night there</u>; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.

Rev 21:25 And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there

Revelation 7:15 Therefore are they <u>before the throne of God</u>, and <u>serve him</u> day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

Revelation 22:4 And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads.

Is 65:17 For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the <u>former shall not be remembered</u>, nor come into mind.

Rev 21:4 And God shall <u>wipe away all tears from their eyes</u>; and there shall be no more <u>death</u>, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Re 21:10 ...shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

This is "New Jerusalem" It is just the capital city. I believe we'll be able to travel anywhere in the universe we want to.

Revelation 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new.

WE'LL SEE MANY WONDERS WITH OUR GLORIFIED EYES BUT THERE WILL BE SOME THINGS THAT WE "REALLY" SEE WHEN WE GET THERE

1. WE'LL SEE OUR SAVIOR WAS WORTHY

We'll see then that our Father was right in what He did while we lived in this world.

We'll see then that He was right. He did what was right.

We may not "see it" now, but we will then. We'll understand it.

2. <u>WE'LL SEE OUR SACRIFICE WAS WORTHWHILE</u>

When He gives us rewards for what we did for His glory, we "see" then IT WAS WORTH IT.

WE'LL "SEE" THEN, GIVING UP THINGS OF THIS WORLD WAS WORTH IT.

Mt 5:12 Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven:

1 Pe 1:4 To an inheritance <u>incorruptible</u>, and <u>undefiled</u>, and that <u>fadeth not away</u>, reserved in heaven for you,

1 Corinthians 3:14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.

1 Cor 3:15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved....

Revelation 4:10–11 The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and <u>cast their crowns before the throne</u>, saying, <u>Thou art worthy</u>, O Lord, <u>to receive glory and honour and power</u>: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

3. WE'LL SEE OUR SIN WAS WICKED

If I could rip any part of the bible out it would be the part about an eternal hell.

I know sin is awful but I struggle with someone going to hell and burning for eternity.

Mk 9:43 ...into the fire that never shall be quenched:

Mt 18:8 ...into everlasting fire.

Mt 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment:

Re 20:10 ...and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

But when I get home, I will "SEE" then like never before how wicked sin is.

We'll see sin like God sees it.

(I don't believe we'll ever see things EXACTLY like God does because we will never be totally LIKE Him. We will always be AMAZED about God)

We'll "see" it then. Sin is so wicked it really does deserve hell.
